51st Iowa Infantry had 38 battle casualties.

Private Walter Wagner was killed in action on June 13, 1899 while on special duty with Battery D of the 6th U.S. Artillery.

Private Alfred J. Boudewyn of Des Moines was listed as missing on March 28, 1899.

36 soldiers were killed in action.

Typhoid fever deaths were high for all regiments.
